Associate Pastor of Middle School Ministries

Focus/Purpose of this Ministry: This associate pastor leads the ministries of Hope Church that relate to middle school students and leads youth worship ministries.

Qualifications:

- 1. This associate pastor must meet the Biblical Qualifications for Leadership.
- 2. This associate pastor must hold an undergraduate degree.
- 3. This associate pastor must subscribe to the Faith Statements of Hope Missionary Church.
- 4. This associate pastor must be (or become) a member of Hope Missionary Church.
- 5. This associate pastor must hold (or pursue) appropriate ministry credentials through the Missionary Church, Inc.

Gifts or Talents:

- 1. A spiritual intensity for God
- 2. A heart for ministry in the church
- 3. A heart for lost people
- 4. A team spirit
- 5. A passion for excellence
- 6. A servant's heart

Ministry Responsibilities:

- 1. Middle School Ministry:
 - a. In cooperation with other student ministry staff members, develop a vision of ministry to students that fits within the vision of Hope Church.
 - b. Lead the ministry of Hope Church to middle school students.
 - c. Oversee the regularly scheduled middle school youth meetings from planning to completion.
 - d. Recruit, train and resource volunteers to serve in all areas of middle school ministry.
 - e. Recruit, develop and lead a Middle School Ministries Leadership Team that helps carryout the overall vision of ministry to students and families.
 - f. Oversee events, outings and retreats for middle school students from planning to completion.
 - g. Lead missions experiences for middle school students.
 - h. Maintain a regular presence on middle school campuses where Hope students attend school.

- i. Ensure wise stewardship of the portion of the Hope Church budget designated for ministries under his oversight.
- j. Maintain meaningful contact and participation with parents in embracing their role of primary responsibility in the spiritual development of their middle school students.
- k. Partner with children's ministry leadership and overall church ministries to engage students in serving within HopeKids.
- I. Collaborate with children's ministry leadership and high school ministry leadership to establish programs and procedures for effective transitions from children's to middle school to high school ministries.
- m. Provide general oversight and leadership for ministry to 5th graders
- n. Recruit, train and resource volunteers to lead ministry to 5th graders
- 2. Youth Worship Ministry:
 - a. Provide oversight and leadership for the youth worship team
 - b. Recruit and train students to lead worship during student ministry meetings
 - c. Purchase/upgrade instruments as needed
 - d. Collaborate with middle & high school ministry leadership to identify potential students to incorporate into worship ministry, as well as gleaning insights to facilitate impactful youth worship experiences
- 3. Share in the preaching ministry as requested by the senior pastor.
- 4. Participate in the pastoral care ministries of Hope Church.
- 5. Participate in various service opportunities of Hope Church as ability and personal schedule permit.
- 6. Other tasks as assigned by supervisor.
